

# Justice Court Wedding Information



## **Does the Park County Justice Court perform wedding ceremonies?**

Yes, the Justice Court judges routinely perform wedding ceremonies, during office hours or by appointment outside of office hours.

## **Do I need to have a marriage license to get married in the state of Montana?**

Yes, you must obtain your license from the Clerk of District Court. You must provide a rubella test along with any documents regarding divorce decrees.

## **Who can perform marriage ceremonies in the state of Montana?**

Any judge, including judges of state and federal courts, Justice of the Peace, minister, or other person of any religious society or sect authorized by the rules of such society to perform the marriage ceremony

## **Is there a fee for having a wedding ceremony performed by a magistrate at the courthouse?**

Yes there is a \$30.00 fee for marriages performed at the court. There is an additional fee for weddings performed away from the court. You must contact the court to determine judge's availability and cost away from the court.

## **Do I need an appointment to be married by a judge at the court facility?**

Yes you should contact the court at (406) 222-4170 or talk with our staff at the court facility after you have picked up your marriage license.
