Review and Consider Allocation Of Park Funds or YRRE Funds Towards RTP Bicycle Path Resurfacing and Enhancement Projects:

The Trail Resurfacing Project has received about \$35, 00.00 and due to MTD required safety requirements the cost has grown to \$78, 00.00. It was hoped that unused CTEP funds slated for Cooke City projects could be used but Cooke City has said they will be using all the funds. Kristen Galbraith, with Nittany Grant Works, is asking the Board to consider if funds could be allocated from the park fund or the YRRE fund for this project. Mike said there is \$15, 327.00 available from subdivision cash-in-lieu that could be used.

The Board discussed what to recommend to the Commissioners regarding which funds and what the funds will be used towards the project.

Martha made a motion to ask the Commissioners to approve the use of cash-in-lieu park funds and YRRE funds for interpretive signage for the Bicycle Path Resurfacing project and ask the Commission to cover any cost overrun not to exceed \$5, 00.00. Cassie Burns seconded, motion passed unanimously.
