

## **Parks and Recreation Board**

May 1, 2013

Park County, Montana

**Attendance:** Board members Martha Miller, Robin Ogata and Carol Woodley; Mike Inman, planning; Clint Tinsley, commissioner; Bill Berg, citizen

**Call to Order:** @3:00p.m., Chair Martha Miller called a meeting to order in the West Room of the City-County Complex.

**Review and Approval of Minutes:** The board reviewed minutes from the March 6, 2013, meeting. *Carol Woodley moved to approve the minutes as presented. Robin Ogata seconded the motion. Motion passed.*

**Public Comment:** None

**Parks and Recreation Survey Results and Discussion:** Inman said 380 individuals started taking the survey and approximately 350 finished it. He said the board currently does not have a breakdown of where survey takers lived in the county. He thinks the survey should remain open and efforts made to capture more survey takers in areas currently not represented, but the board can move forward with attempting to prioritize projects. The board reviewed survey responses.

**General Updates:** Inman said he thinks the board can better pursue projects with the sitting Commission, potentially with Community Transportation Enhancement Program (CTEP) and Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds, including the proposed Highway 89 South bike trail extension and Castle Mountain Road trail. Inman said he was working with the county commission on formalizing the process to abandon a county road to include all applicable departments and boards, and the civil deputy county attorney was tasked with providing a legal opinion on the Chico-Chicory Trail access issue.

**Discussion of June Agenda:** The board will identify and prioritize tasks to move proposed projects forward; review survey results; have a Chico-Chicory trail update; and Inman will research Poor Farm signage and discuss project funding options with Nittany Grantworks.
