Position is responsible for conducting public relations activities and participating in professional development opportunities. QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must hold a current Montana Post Certification or other State equivalent --OR-- minimally must be pre-certified with the Montana Law Enforcement Testing Consortium prior to application being submitted. EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: Graduate of an accredited high school or the equivalent thereof; be of good moral character; never been convicted of a felony; agrees to be examined by a physician licensed to practice in the State of MT within 30 days immediately preceding the date of employment offer. CERTIFICATIONS/LICENSES/REGISTRATIONS: Valid MT Driver's license; MLEA certification (must obtain within 1 year of hiring date); valid and current POST Certification. OTHER SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Able to efficiently operate a computer, have effective communication skills and good people skills. PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.
