#### Updates are released Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

- FEMA, the SBA, and Montana Disaster and Emergency Services are opening a Disaster Recovery Center in Livingston on Wednesday, July 13 at Park High School. The center will be open 7 days a week, from 8am to 6pm. FEMA and SBA specialists can provide assistance with filling out applications and provide referrals to other relevant organizations. It is not necessary to go to a center to apply for assistance.
- The Small Business Administration Business Recovery Center at the Livingston Chamber of Commerce (303 E. Park St, Livingston) is open Monday Friday, 9am to 6pm with representatives there in-person to help business owners apply for assistance.
- FEMA representatives will be at the Gardiner School from Monday, July 11 through Saturday, July 16 from 9am to 5pm daily. Representatives can assist with applications, inquiries, and referrals.
- The Red Cross of Montana has financial assistance available to help with flood recovery for those whose homes suffered major damage or were destroyed. Please call 800-ARC-MONT or 800-272-6668. Deadline to apply is Friday 7/29/22. This assistance does not impact any assistance you may get from FEMA, your insurance company, any income, or any other agency.
- The Southwest Montana Flood Relief Fund is still accepting applications from those affected by flooding. To fill out the application visit <u>this link</u>. Or call the Park County Community Foundation at 406-224-3920.
