Updates are released Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

- A FEMA Disaster Recovery Center is opening in Livingston on **Wednesday, July 13** at Park High School. **The center will be open 7 days a week, from 8am to 6pm.** FEMA and SBA specialists can provide assistance with filling out applications and provide referrals to other organizations.
- The Small Business Administration Business Recovery Center at the Livingston Chamber of Commerce (303 E. Park St, Livingston) is open **Monday - Friday, 9am to 6pm** with representatives there in-person to help business owners apply for assistance.
- FEMA representatives are at the Mt. Republic Chapel of Peace between Cooke City and Silver Gate from **Tuesday, July 12 through Saturday, July 16 from 9am to 6pm daily.** Representatives can assist with applications, inquiries, and referrals.
- FEMA representatives are at the Gardiner School through **Saturday, July 16 from 9am to 5pm daily.** Representatives can assist with applications, inquiries, and referrals.
- A SBA Business Recovery Center is opening at the Gardiner Community Center on Wednesday, July 13. The center will be open **Monday - Friday, 9am to 6pm** with representatives there in-person to help business owners apply for assistance.
- FEMA and SBA representatives held a virtual information session with Gardiner, Cooke City and Silver Gate residents today discussing available assistance.
- The Red Cross of Montana has financial assistance available to help with flood recovery. Please call 800-ARC-MONT or 800-272-6668. Deadline to apply is Friday 7/29/22. This assistance does not impact assistance you may get from FEMA, your insurance company, or any other agency.
- The Southwest Montana Flood Relief Fund is still accepting applications from those affected by flooding. To fill out the application visit [this link](#). Or call the Park County Community Foundation at 406-224-3920.

- Residents who need help with flood clean up can call 2-1-1 or 406-201-1173 to get connected with Crisis Cleanup teams and other resources.
