Business Recovery Center in Gardiner: The Small Business Administration is opening a Business Recovery Center at the Gardiner Community Center on Wednesday, July 13. Businesses can have their questions answered, receive help with applications and be provided referrals to other resources.

Disaster Recovery Center: FEMA, the SBA, and Montana Disaster and Emergency Services are opening a Disaster Recovery Center beginning Wednesday, July 13th at Park High School. Open 7 days a week from 8am to 6pm. Individuals and businesses can receive help submitting applications, have questions answered, and find referrals to other organizations. No appointment necessary and all services are provided free of charge.

FEMA Representatives in Gardiner: FEMA will have representatives at Gardiner High School through Saturday, July 16 from 9AM to 5PM daily. Representatives to assist with applications, inquiries, updates, and referrals.

Gardiner/Cooke City Virtual Information Session: Montana DES hosted a virtual call for the public with FEMA and SBA representatives to provide information on flood recovery resources on Monday, July 11th.

Physical copies can be obtained at the Yellowstone Plaza near the large "Yellowstone" Sign at the park entrance.

Yellowstone River: A large hazard of concrete and rebar exists in the river at the end of the town stretch in Gardiner. **STAY RIVER LEFT.** Be alert for new hazards and obstacles, especially as water levels recede. The Army Corp of Engineers has begun initial surveys to assess removing river hazards. See <https://fwp.mt.gov/news> for more information and updates on closures.

Federal Credit Union Mobile Branch: The Federal Credit Union will set up a mobile branch in the Baptist Church Parking lot on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 09:30am to 3:00pm.

Medical Needs: MedCor Mammoth Mobile Clinic will be operating an urgent care and walk-in medical clinic in Gardiner on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 8:30am to 5pm. The clinic will be located inside the Yellowstone National Park boundary across from Yellowstone Forever. The Mobile Clinic can also help set up telehealth appointments with Mammoth Clinic. Mammoth Clinic is open Monday through Thursday, 8:30am to 5pm. Call 307-344-7965 for questions or to set up an in-person or telehealth appointment. If you have a medical emergency, call 911.

Flood related refuse: Natural river debris can be disposed of at the Chico Green boxes from 10am-4pm. If the boxes are full, DO NOT place debris on the ground – please come back another time.

YNP Limited Opening: The Northern part of the Park is open to foot traffic except for specific local closures. The Old Yellowstone Trail between Gardiner and Mammoth is closed to bicycle and foot traffic. North and Northeast Entrances remain closed to vehicle traffic. FEMA in Cooke City: FEMA representatives have arrived in Cooke City to assist residents with applying for assistance. They will be at the Mt. Republic Chapel of Peace located between Cooke City and Silver Gate from 9AM-6PM through Sat., July 16.
