- FEMA center hours at the Gardiner School have been extended. **New hours are 8am to 6pm, 7 days a week.** The SBA is located at both the Gardiner School and Gardiner Community Center.
- A FEMA center will be opening in the Emigrant Community Hall on Monday, July 18. **It will be open from 9am to 5pm, through Friday, July 22.**
- **Rain and hail in the Cooke City/Silver Gate area have caused additional minor flooding over Highway 212. Crews are working to address problems.**
