

Parks and Recreation Board Meeting Minutes

June 1, 2016
Park County, Montana

Attendance: Board Members: Robin Ogata, Cassie Burns, Carol Woodley, Martha Miller, Cara McNeely; Michael Inman, Park County Planning; Jeanne-Marie Souvigney, Livingston Parks and Trails Committee

Call to Order: 3:00 p.m.; Community Room, City/County Complex

Review and Approval of Minutes May 04, 2016: *Woodley made a motion to approve the May Meeting Minutes. Burns seconded, motion passed unanimously.*

Public Comment: Souvigney explained to the Board that she was present to help continue fostering the relationship between the City of Livingston and Park County when it comes to active transportation planning. There was some Board discussion surrounding support of Vision Livingston in their efforts to beautify Livingston through projects such as the traffic light art wraps. Inman made suggestions as to how the Board could support them. Inman stated he would reach out to members of Vision Livingston and invite them to the next Parks and Recreation Board Meeting. McNeely brought up an active transportation meeting coming up on June 8th, Mike distinguished the difference between that meeting and the one being discussed.

Active Transportation Plan Updates: Inman gave a brief history of the active transportation related events that have been leading up to joint meetings with the City of Livingston to discuss active transportation. Inman also stated that the City Parks and Trails Committee has requested a joint meeting with this Board for their June 22 meeting and the Planning Department has been working on what that meeting may look like.

July Farmer's Market Event: Inman explained that Park County and the City of Livingston would be working together to provide an active transportation living lab at the July 27, 2016 farmer market. The living lab would consist of temporary demonstrations of safe shared and alternative use as well as education and media coverage on the different aspects of the demonstration.

Discussion of Relationship with City Recreation and Joint Project Priority List: Inman briefly repeated what he had covered in the Active Transportation Plan Updates section including the details of the upcoming joint meeting on June 22, 2016.

Project Updates: Inman gave an update on various county projects including the Carter's Bridge Trail Extension, the Chico Cemetery and bridal falls.

Discussion of July Agenda: Inman suggested that the Board wait and see how the upcoming joint meeting goes before scheduling a July Board meeting. Woodley inquired about the funding utilized for cemetery purchase.
