Review/Recommendations of Park County Active Transportation Plan: Inman informed the Board that every year the Active Transportation plan was supposed to be reviewed every year for updates with an extensive review every five years. Inman went on to state that Kristen Galbraith had submitted some draft changes concerning grammar and content information updates and that now was the Board's chance to look at the Plan and make any suggested edits or changes. The Board discussed the process before deciding to postpone making a recommendation to the Commission on draft changes until the next meeting to allow additional time for review.

Project Updates: Inman updated the Board that the County had met with a representative from Western Federal Highways onsite to kick off the planning grant process for Old Yellowstone South. Inman updated the Board that curbs had been placed adjacent to the trail running next to the sleeping giant center to protect the trail from being parked on. Inman updated the Board that Park County and Livingston would be hosting the Building Active Communities Institute Conference this year. Inman updated the Board that there would be a meeting at 5:30 on November 1st to discuss the potential of modifying the downtown design to include recommended active transportation aspects recommended for safe inclusive travel.

Discussion of Next Meeting's Agenda: Inman stated the Board would not be meeting at their regularly scheduled November meeting since it was a week away and would instead likely reconvene in December.
