**Bicycle Trail Extension and Resurfacing Project Update:** The county has not heard back from MTAP about awarding of funds to extend the existing bicycle trail along 89 South ending at East River Road. A decision now may not be made until the end of February. MDT may consider funding all applications, which would likely lessen the dollar amount perhaps initially allotted to the project.
