Review and Approval of Minutes: The board reviewed minutes from the June 4, 2014, meeting. Cassie Burns noted she was not in attendance at the meeting. *Cassie Burns moved to accept the minutes as revised. Robin Ogata seconded the motion. Motion passed.*

Public Comment: The pedestal sign is completed and will be stored in the transfer station building until it can be placed by county personnel. Placement location needs to be determined.

Confluence Park Update: The County received the grant to purchase the property, which will provide unlimited personal and limited commercial access to the Yellowstone River in Gardiner in perpetuity.

Chico/Chicory Trail Access Update: A site visit will not take place until the MACo attorney returns to work after an injury.

Park County Trails Plan Update: Mike Inman said he would like a comprehensive catalogue of county easements and data providing description, history and challenges associated with each. He would also like a cost estimate for connecting Livingston and Yellowstone NP with a trail, and options/alternative routes for such a trail.

Martha Miller said the commissioners approved placing an ADA accessible port-o-let toilet at Silver Gate Park.
