Work Completed This Week:

- Drill-rig subcontractor returned to the site on Monday. Preboring of the east abutment was completed on Tuesday.
- Pile driving was completed at the east abutment.
- Piles at both the west and east abutments were encased in concrete. Each side required one day to set prior to forming the abutment cap.
- The west and east abutment caps were formed, and rebar cages were set.
- Concrete for both the west and east abutment caps was poured.

Work to be Completed Next Week:

- Concrete for the west and east abutments will be curing this week. Concrete requires a minimum of three days, but up to 7 days, to cure prior to setting beams. *Therefore, there may be periods of inactivity on site this week.*
- Beam set is schedule for the end of the week. A specific date has not been set as permits for transporting the beams have not been secured by the supplier.
- The contractor will be working on placing and compacting fill material up to the concrete cap.
- The contractor will be working tying rebar cages for the backwalls and wingwalls.
