

Park County would like to invite members of the public to attend a presentation of the Draft Upper Yellowstone Channel Migration Map; public input and comments are encouraged. Following the 2022 Yellowstone River flood, Park County was awarded funding through the DNRC Reclamation and Development Planning Grant Program to update the 2009 Upper Yellowstone Channel Migration Map between Gardiner and Springdale. The Migration Map is a non-regulatory tool that illustrates historic river channel movement over time and identifies locations that are susceptible to future channel movement. Three public meetings will be held where the consultant team will present the draft map to the public, answer questions and receive input. Once finalized, the completed map will be made available on the internet in the form of an interactive mapping tool that the public can access free of charge.
