2. To write in a name, completely fill in the oval to the left of the line provided, and on the line provided print the name of the write-in candidate for whom you wish to vote.
3. DO NOT MAKE AN IDENTIFYING MARK, CROSS OUT, ERASE, OR USE CORRECTION FLUID. If you make a mistake or change your mind, exchange your ballot for a new one.

REFERENDUM NO. R-001 TO REPEAL THE
PARK COUNTY GROWTH POLICY
(VOTE IN ONE OVAL)

The purpose of this referendum is to repeal the Park County Growth Policy Update adopted April 20, 2017, pursuant to Resolution No. 1243, and the addendum adopted November 29, 2022. The growth policy is a nonregulatory document used by Park County as a guide for making decisions about its future, particularly with regard to land use. The growth policy can provide the legal basis for the adopting or updating of zoning or subdivision regulations. Park County is not required to have a growth policy unless the Board of County Commissioners wishes to amend or adopt zoning regulations.

REFERENDUM NO. R-002 TO REQUIRE A
VOTE TO ADOPT A GROWTH POLICY
(VOTE IN ONE OVAL)

If the County Commission adopts a resolution of intention to adopt a growth policy, the County Commission must submit to the qualified electors of the area covered by the growth policy proposed by the County Commission at the next primary or general election or at a special election the referendum question of whether or not the growth policy should be adopted. Whether to put the adoption of a growth policy to a vote of qualified electors is currently within the discretion of the County Commission.

FOR requiring a vote by qualified electors of the area covered by the proposed growth policy of whether or not a growth policy should be adopted.

AGAINST requiring a vote by qualified electors of the area covered by the proposed growth policy of whether or not a growth policy should be adopted.
