 submitted to the Clerk & Recorder.

- o Whether or not the adjoining landowners consent to the petition.
- Where consent is not given, the probable cost of the right-of-way.
- Necessity for and advantage of the petitioned action.
- A complete list of all adjoining landowners using or adjoining the road including their property tax identification number. (Tax ID Numbers are available from County Treasurer).
- o Proof that all landowners and adjoining landowners have been notified of the petition.
- o Signature page of the freeholder(s) requesting the, alteration or abandonment of the county road.
- o Printed Name of the Freeholder. 10 free holders are required per state statute.
- o Freeholders Tax ID number.
- Complete Mailing Address
- o Signature Line.
- \$300.00 filing fee. It is the responsibility of the person submitting the petition that it meets the requirements set by the state of Montana and Park County prior to submitting the petition. Filing fee is not refundable. Filing fee may be waived by the board of commissioners. If fee is waived a letter from the commission waiving the fee must accompany the petition when it is submitted to the Clerk & Recorder.



WHEREAS, a petition to abandon a portion of a platted unnamed alley in the Townsite of Wilsall, Park County, Montana, was submitted on March 5, 2003, by the Wilsall Rodeo Association;

WHEREAS, the petitioner affirmed that the abandonment of the unnamed alley would guarantee unrestricted access to the Wilsall Rodeo ground, square their property boundaries, that the unnamed alley has not been maintained by Park County, and that the abandonment of the alley will not have any adverse affect for any adjacent property owners;

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the petition was held March 31, 2003, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Room in the Park County Courthouse after proper notice of the hearing was published; and

WHEREAS, after the hearing the commissioners considered the petition and the comments at the hearing and determined that it was in the public interest to abandon the unnamed alley as described above and is not needed by the residents of Park County for any public purpose. The

commissioners moved to abandon the unnamed street as described above:

There are no other parties that require the road or alley for access to their property.


Both parties have entered into a Consent to Road Abandonment, and have agreed to relocate their boundaries after the abandonments as shown on Exhibit A1.


